DEAR COLLEAGUES,

On behalf of the California Society of Anesthesiologists (CSA) Educational Programs Division, we are excited to invite you to join us at the beautiful Hyatt Regency Mission Bay, San Diego.

After more than two long years of coping with the pandemic, the main theme for this year's meeting is to refresh, review and relax. The program is packed with great speakers on a variety of topics from a hands-on POCUS & Regional Anesthesia workshop to a TED style pediatric anesthesia panel focusing on common pediatric problems. This year's program will also provide enhanced tools needed to deliver high-quality patient care as anesthesiology care evolves. The program provides sessions grouped by specialty interest with expert speakers from throughout California and across the nation. New this year will be a fantastic session on diversity, equity, and equality, with national leaders in the field.

interested.

The plenary sessions focus on updates in specialty areas and feature a combination of high-yield lectures, panel discussions and question / answer components. As you'll see in the schedule, we have a broad range of topic areas covering peri-anesthesia care.

We are including Abstracts as part of our general session, in both poster and oral presentation formats. Attendance at these abstracts includes CME credit. This will be an excellent opportunity to share recent research with your fellow colleagues and peers! New this year is an opportunity for the session moderators all of whom are experts in their fields to present the top articles in their specialty. The audience will get to vote on the most influential or important article!

We are continuing our highly successful and well received Practice Management sessions. These discussions will highlight updates in leadership, business administration, and practice performance issues that are of critical importance in today's anesthesiology practice environments.

Our Sunday session is focused on Optimal and Responsible Pain Management. Our speakers will provide insight from pain management, legal, regulatory, and health system points of view. 
