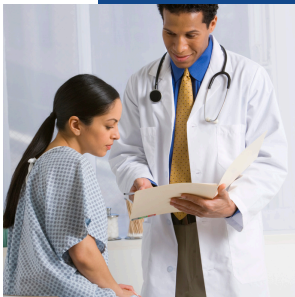
MEDICAL FENTANYL

STREET FENTANYL



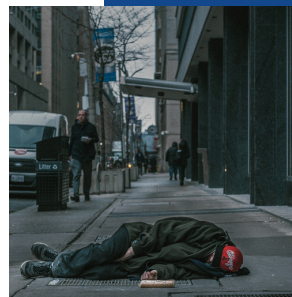
Sold on the streets or through illegal online markets.
